Date	Details
Tuesday 12 th November 2019	Fitzwilliam Museum, Cambridge. One of the leading collections of Greek and Roman antiquities in Europe. We will find out about Ancient Greek life and come face to face with artefacts over 3000 years old.
Wednesday 15 th January 2020	Natural History Museum, London. Here we will experience what it is like to be caught in a volcano or earthquake and find out how scientists predict and prevent them. We will also look round the amazing collections at the museum.
Monday 8 th June 2020	Flag Fen, Bronze Age Site. At this world famous archaeological site, we will spend the day living at the Bronze age people did and find out how life change from the Stone age to the Iron age in our local area.

Staff are mindful that school trips and visits are an additional cost for parents and can, at times, be difficult to afford for families. Therefore, we have ensured that this year's trips will have a **total cost of £30 for the year per child**. This is a voluntary contribution, however without the full amount from each child, trips may not be able to go ahead. Parents can choose to pay £10 per term for their child's trips or can make a smaller payment towards the cost each month at the office. Office staff will be happy to arrange a payment plan for parents who request it.


