A note from Miss Lawson

Welcome back to the Spring term. I hope you all had a lovely break over Christmas and that you are looking forward to the year ahead.

The children have come back to school and it has been lovely to visit class-rooms and see how eager the children are to get back to their learning. Our aim is to ensure that all children make as much progress as they possibly can whilst maintaining a broad and balanced curriculum. Your children will study a range of subjects this term, details of which can be found on our website under your child's year group. Please take a look at these as it will help you in your discussions at home when asking what they have done at school.

Attendance continues to be a priority as the better the attendance, the greater progress your child will make. We are very aware that there are a number of illnesses that are circulating at this current time and would advise the following:

- 1. Stay at home if you are unwell **and have a fever** you could be infected by a seasonal virus.
- 2. Practice good personal hygiene, i.e. regular handwashing.
- 3. Practice good respiratory hygiene, i.e. catch-it, bin-it, and kill-it.
- 4. Get vaccinated if eligible.
- 5. Children infected with scarlet fever must stay at home for at least 24-hours after the start of antibiotic treatment. Siblings can continue to attend their settings if they are well and do not have any symptoms such as sore throats, fever, chills, and muscle aches.

If you are unsure about whether your child can attend school, please contact the school office.

School Uniform

May I take this opportunity to remind you about our school uniform policy.

School uniform must be worn at all times. This comprises of:

Grey/ black skirt or trousers, white polo shirt, Red and White Dress, Red Jumper or Cardigan and Black School Shoes.

Please can you ensure all uniform is labelled to ensure that anything that is lost is returned to it's rightful owner.

Please can I remind you that heeled shoes or boots are not to be worn.

Jewellery and Make Up

A small pair of earring studs are allowed to be worn, as is a watch. For health and safety reasons, no other jewellery is allowed to be worn which includes hooped earrings.
